


Shooting Up: Infections and other injectingrelated harms among people who inject drugs in the United Kingdom

Data published in the latest Shooting Up report shows that among people who inject psychoactive drugs in 2020:

HIV prevalence

1 in 100 are HIV positive, but outbreaks continue to occur



Currently infected with HCV

The proportion of people currently infected with hepatitis C has decreased in recent years, likely due to increased testing and treatment



15% have never had a diagnostic hepatitis C test

Just under half

haven't had a recent HCV test

HBV vaccination (all PWID)

1/3 have never been vaccinated for hepatitis B




Just under half

of PWID reported being homeless in the last year




Groin injecting remains common, with over

1/3 reporting injecting into this site



1 in 4 reported inserting the needles 4 or more times before finding a vein




38% reported symptoms of an injection site infection in the last year



Almost **2/3** reported reusing their own injecting equipment in the past month

The proportion reporting sharing of any injecting equipment has increased to 43%





with only reporting receiving naloxone
