Thank you for your correspondence on 2nd September. The content of which has been noted.

Regarding your concerns about menthol flavoured tobacco, we have been advised by the EU Commission on July 7th that a number of products are actively being investigated by them, working alongside the Swedish Competent Authority. This is in accordance with the process under Article 3 of the EU Commission implementing Regulation (EU) 2016/779.

As the United Kingdom must continue to comply with the Commissioning Regulations during this transition period, any independent UK investigations are now on hold. Once the current EU/Swedish investigation has been concluded a decision will be made on any further action required by UK government and enforcement agencies.
