Employments

I am a Professor in the Department of Psychology at the University of British Columbia, where I am also the the Director of the Centre for Gambling Research at UBC. The Centre for Gambling Research is supported by funding from the Province of British Columbia government and the British Columbia Lottery Corporation (BCLC) to the University of British Columbia. The BCLC is a Canadian Crown Corporation. The BCLC and BC government do not control our research program and do not impose any constraints on publishing.

Commercial/business interests

Since 2015, I have received honoraria for grant reviews from Gambling Research Exchange Ontario (Canada) and the National Center for Responsible Gaming (US). I have received speaker travel expenses from Svenska Spel (Sweden), the National Association for Gambling Studies (Australia), and the Alberta Gambling Research Institute (Canada).
