Problem and Approach

- Cambridge City Council, South Cambridgeshire District Council and Huntingdonshire District Council (3C) joined together to implement a range of shared services to deliver better services whilst reducing the running costs of each council, including legal.
- The aim of joining up the legal departments was for the three councils to make a collective 15 per cent saving while giving a better service and have better buying power for external support. By joining resources, 3C could not only afford to have more in- house specialist legal roles, but also adopt new ways of working.

Outcomes

- A 15 per cent saving across the three councils
- A successful merger of the three legal teams into one
- New software implemented on time to support the merged function.
