## Problem and Approach

- Like all Councils both Lewes and Eastbourne Councils have faced the combined challenge of reduced government funding and growing demand for services.
- Both councils have had to find creative ways of generating income to enable us to continue to provide quality services whilst also providing opportunities for economic growth and prosperity.
- The unique approach at Lewes and Eastbourne has been to bring the two council's staff teams together through our Joint Transformation Programme whilst at the same time embedding a culture of innovation, creativity and commercialism to deliver a range of commercial solutions to tackle our financial, economic and social challenges.

## Outcomes

- The JTP amounted to a £8.2m shared investment resulting in savings of £3.4m per annum.
- The establishing of Arms-Length companies to support with further income generation
