
City innovation




Technology innovation



The Coruña Smart City technology platform permits capturing and managing the inherent data complexity of the infrastructure and human activities in the city.

Service innovation

Inclusion of data from different sources for generating higher value-added services.



An Open Data treatment for Smart data, so they can be used and exploited by third parties.

Advanced support for the construction of intelligent services for the public.

Service innovation

Main portal open to the public, collaborators and municipal managers for accessing the knowledge and services of Coruña Smart City.

Gives access to contents and services appropriate for each group and/or area of interest.

Objectives


- Development of the innovative know-how and economic/ business stimulation in the region
