

## An Update from Edinburgh Young Carers



#### PETE'S PEDAL FOR YOUNG CARERS

Peter Wright, founder and patron of the Green Team, cycled 941km around the watershed of Scotland to raise funds to enable The Green Team to support young carers to enjoy time outdoors in nature. Peter completed the solo cycle following the Scottish watershed route as closely as possible. He started the challenge on the 18th August from the Scottish Borders, winding his way across the country to his finishing point in the North of Scotland in Duncansby Bay, almost 950 kilometres and 24 days later. #### DRUG AND ALCOHOL PROJECT GOOD NEWS STORIES!

We are thrilled to announce that four of our +16 YCs have managed to find a job over the last month, one of them after being referred to the Wellbeing and Employability Service of Canongate Youth. This is the result of preparation and lots of hard work, we couldn't be prouder!

Some of our YCs have made great progress thanks to the swimming classes delivered by the Royal Commonwealth pool. Every Thursday, they learn about coordination, balance and motor skills, and they also develop their own social skills. Instructors at the RCP are so impressed about how quickly they are developing their swimming skills! Finally, Last month we had the chance to run four horse riding groups at the Drum RDA. The money raised by the Drum allowed 26 YCs access these sessions, which helped them work on their confidence, empathy, communication and trust.

After a couple of weeks of not getting any response, we started to get a bit disheartened that this wasn't going to happen. Then Man Utd got back to us asking which game the young person would like to go to? Followed by Hotel Football who offered the young person and his mum an overnight stay. Two goals scored, just waiting for the hattrick!!! After 6 phone calls on hold to first Transpennine for roughly about 4 hours, we have the hattrick, our young carer is off to see his idol and his dream is going to become a reality.
