Drop in Clinics

If you are 16 or 17 years old, you are eligible for your COVID-19 vaccination. You do not need to be registered with a GP to come to a drop-in clinic, just visit any drop-in clinic that offers the Pfizer vaccine. No appointment necessary and can deliver both first and second vaccine doses (as long as you received your first injection of the COVID-19 vaccine at least eight weeks before).
