








## Easter Egg Hunt

# **Drinks Carton Bird Feeder**

#### Making these Owl Bird Feeders is relatively quick and easy, but you do need to allow for drying times!

What you will need:

- a juice carton
- paints
- scissors
- plastic bottle lids
- googly eyes
- Glue

#### 1. Paint the Juice Carton

Start off by painting the juice/ milk carton.

#### 2. Cut out your owl feeder shapes

Once dry ask a grown up to help cut out a "tummy and wings" into the bottom half of your juice or milk carton.

Be careful not to cut the wings all the way out, you want to keep the "flaps" attached. This keeps the seeds a little bit more sheltered and gives you those lovely owl wings!

#### 3. Add the bottle top Owl Eyes


Finally, take your juice carton and glue on your bottle top eyes.

#### 4. Fill with bird food

Punch a little hole at the top on the bird feeder and tie some string or rope through so it can be hung outside.

Fill with food/ bird seed







