- ID number: National insurance number, or BRP number










- You may be asked to confirm your date of birth and/or address when you phone your GP

# Key words

- Online something that is done while connected to the internet / a computer
- **Digital** using or storing data via a computer system
- Confidentiality the principle of keeping information private or secret as agreed
- Access acquire or obtain information, to a service or a space
- Safe space a place or environment where individuals can come together without
- discrimination or criticism
- **Personal data** information that can identify an individual
- **Privacy** being free from attention or observation by others
- **Mute** temporarily pausing sound coming from a person
- Video moving visual images which can be shared with other people
- **Communication** exchanging and/or receiving information such as through speaking or writing
- Essential Services services which are essential to an individual for a minimum standard of living
