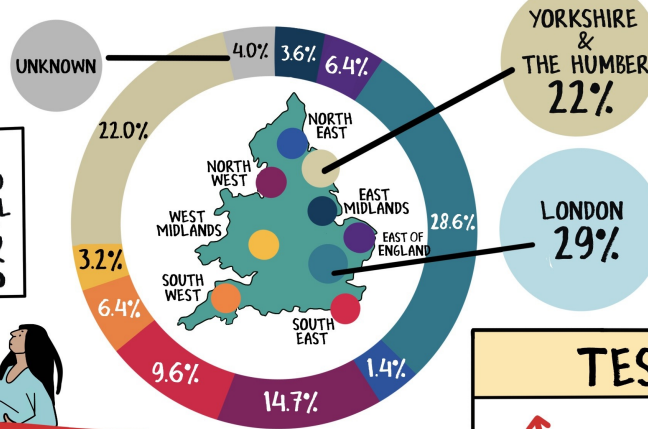

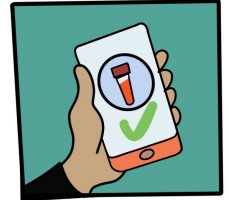
HELPING REACH PEOPLE AT HIGHER RISK OF HIV
